NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES (INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES)

The following non-regular classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

Veteran Class I - For Dogs or Bitches at least eight (8) years and under ten (10) years of age on the day of the show.

Veteran Class II - For Dogs or Bitches at least ten (10) years and under twelve (12) years of age on the day of the show.

Veteran Class III - For Dogs or Bitches at least twelve (12) years of age on the day of the show.

Versatility/Hunter Certificate Class - For dogs or bitches that have earned a Junior, Senior, or Master Hunter title under AKC rules or that have earned a Versatility Certificate (VC) or Versatility Excellent Certificate (VCX) under GRCA rules. (Photocopy of VC/VCX Certificate must be attached to entry).

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES (INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES)

Stud Dog Class* - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. The Get must be entered individually in one of the regular classes, Best of Breed, or some other non-regular class other than Stud Dog. Judging will be based on the merits of the Get.

Brood Bitch Class* - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed Bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls at least 9 years and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls at least 12 years and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls at least 15 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls at least 9 years and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls at least 12 years and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls at least 15 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Event Records Department, (919) 854-0195. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of the entry form.

The handler of a Sweepstakes exhibit must be limited to the owner, co-owner, breeder, or a member of their immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made. Entry fee is \$15.00. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class."

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors on Friday evening, April 4, 2008 no earlier than 7:00 p.m. and only AFTER all rings, mats and equipment are set up by members of the Golden Retriever Club of Greater St. Louis. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best of Breed judging on Sunday, April 6, 2008.

The building will be locked at 10:30 p.m. both Friday and Saturday nights and will be opened at 7:30 a.m. both Saturday and Sunday mornings. No dogs are allowed in the building overnight.

Overnight parking of motor homes and trailers will be permitted only in the lower parking lot (across from the playground) on Friday and Saturday nights with permission of the Complex Manager (314-894-3089). Units must be self-contained (no electrical, water or plumbing hook-ups available).

Crating & grooming in designated areas only. Private exercise pens will not be allowed in the building. There will be no space provided for unentered dogs at this show.

A **Booster Bath** will be available for dog bathing.

GATEWAY GOLDEN RESCUE will be providing continental breakfast and lunch each day, along with contributions of homemade dishes from GRC-GSL club members. All donations will be gratefully accepted and will go directly to Rescue. (No food concessions at the show site.)

Dogs are not allowed in the lobby, restrooms or concession area of the recreation complex.

County Ordinance prohibits smoking in the Recreation Complex.

Refund of entry fees (less \$10.00 per entry) for bitches entered in Obedience that come in season after closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary. This certificate must be postmarked before the opening day of the show or presented to the Show Secretary before the start of the show.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All prizes are offered by the Golden Retriever Club of Greater St. Louis through the generosity of its members and friends. A complete list of contributors will be printed in the catalog.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition be action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

No refund for duplicate entries.

No refunds of overpayments totaling \$5.00 or less.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
